## The Rise and Fall of Alexander the Great

**Daniel 11:3-4** 

- 1. His invasion of Persia was largely a retaliation to the attack of Xerxes.
- 2. His conquest of the ancient world took only 5 years.
- 3. He died a premature death in his imperial capital, Babylon in 323 BC.
- 4. His empire was divided between his four generals
  - a. Cassander ruled Macedonia Greece.
  - b. Lysimachus ruled Thrace Asia Minor.
  - c. Seleucus ruled the rest of Asia except for Palestine.
  - d. Ptolemy ruled Egypt and Palestine.
